*You will be matched with a volunteer attorney, who will connect with you by phone or zoom and will help determine your eligibility, prepare your expungement forms, and answer any questions you may have.

You may be eligible for record sealing if your **entire record** fits into one of these two tracks:

TRACK 1:	TRACK 2:
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 5 or fewer felony convictions <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - No convictions higher than a fourth-degree felony - Any number of misdemeanors <p>BUT, to be eligible under this track, you cannot have a conviction for an offense of violence or a felony sex offense.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 felony, - 1 felony and 1 misdemeanor, OR - 2 misdemeanors <p>This track has three exceptions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minor misdemeanors do not count toward your number of convictions. • Multiple convictions from the same incident may be counted as one conviction. • Convictions for related criminal acts committed within three months of each other that were handled by the same court at the same time may count as one conviction.

Note: You cannot seal your record if you are currently on probation, community control, or owe any fines or costs. F1, F2, and OVI convictions are not eligible for sealing. If you are not eligible, you should ask about a Certificate of Qualification for Employment.
